Debuted in 2012 with the work collection "Monster." This debut work received high praise from magic fans worldwide and was featured in major magic magazines such as "Genii," "Linking Ring," and "MAGIC." Since then, often introduced as a "monster" of the magic world by the media.

Specializes in "close-up magic" performed in front of the audience, and won the national competition in Japan in 2011, becoming the youngest champion in history at 17 years old. In the 2014 Asian Games ("FISM ASIA 2014"), won second place and was selected as the "Japanese representative" for the world competition ("FISM 2015"), known as the Olympics of the magic world, held every three years. In recent years, has also been devoted to the development of magic culture, and in 2021, published the work collection "The Monster of the Secret Art," which is a culmination of personal achievements. In 2022, received the highest award in Japan for the most active close-up magician of the year, the "Best Close-up Magician 2022," from the "Nippon Magic Foundation."

Currently, regularly appears as a judge on the TV program "Magic Dragon ~Reiwa no Ryu~," which features Japan's magic battles.
